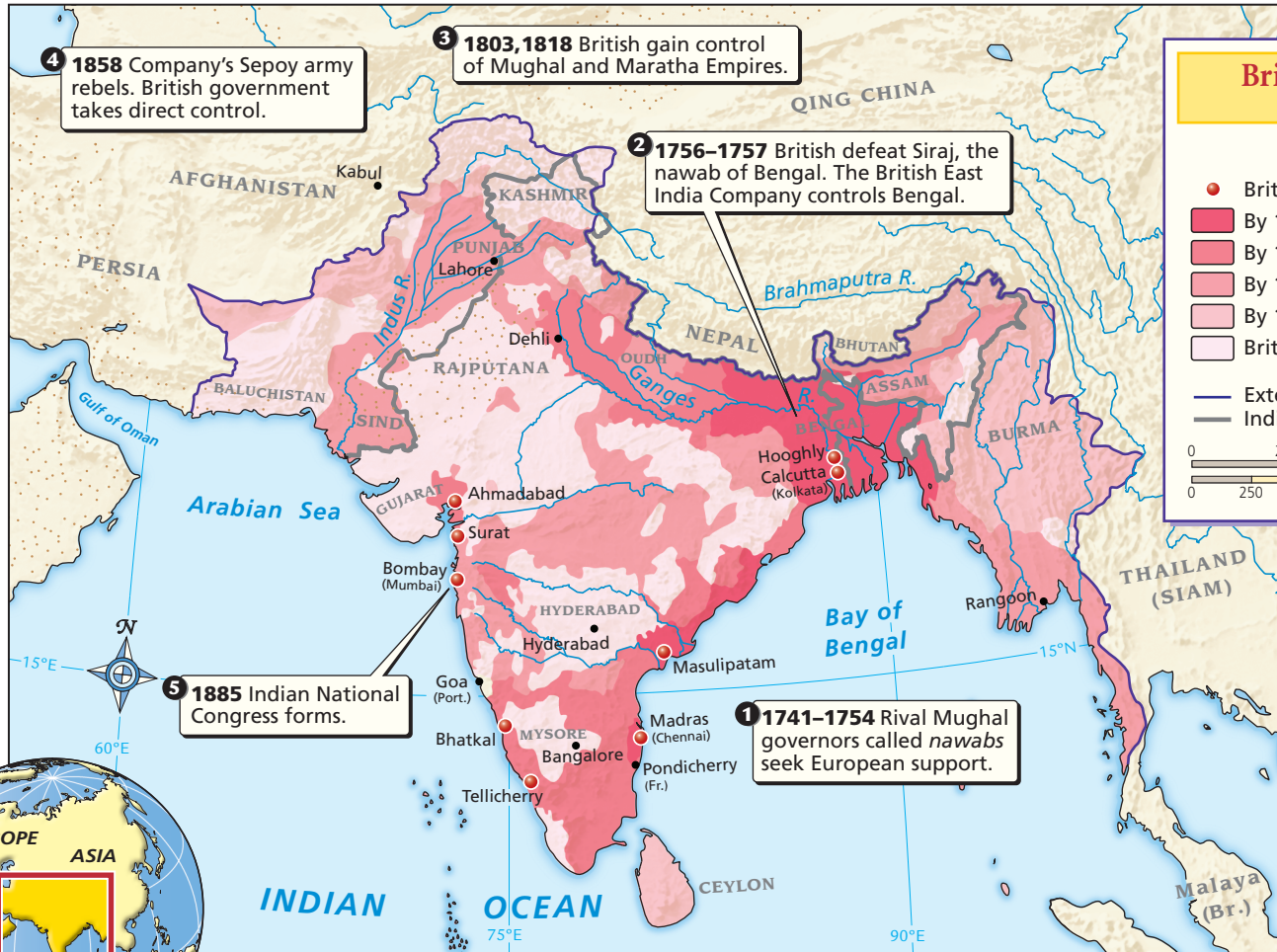
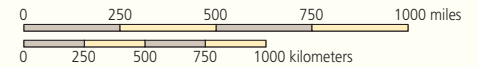


British Conquest of India 1600–1914

4 **1858** Company's Sepoy army rebels. British government takes direct control.

3 **1803, 1818** British gain control of Mughal and Maratha Empires.

2 **1756–1757** British defeat Siraj, the nawab of Bengal. The British East India Company controls Bengal.

5 **1885** Indian National Congress forms.

1 **1741–1754** Rival Mughal governors called *nawabs* seek European support.
